use development where you’ll find Bol, a 10-lane bowling emporium that opened this summer. “In the \$19 million range,” Bol operating partner Barry Davis reports.

That exclamation-point luxury set the standard for everything at Bol, says Davis. That goes for lanes (supplied by Brunswick) that are white with

flecks of wood grain and custom balls that look like billiard balls. Also in the swing of things are a Maine lobster personal pizza, lamb finger sandwiches stuffed with carrot salad and tzatziki, and homemade potato chips on the menu created by chef Eric Wupperman.

Mom-and-pop the town may be, but also, as Davis says about Bol, “there’s lots of eye candy going on.” ♦
